

CREATE YOUR OWN BANNER

A STEP BY STEP GUIDE

SUPPLIES



9' x 6' ft
Canvas Drop Cloth



Plastic drop cloth



Tape



Gesso



Brushes / Paint Rollers /
Paint Trays



Paint



Projector



Grommets (+hammer)
*optional

STEP 1

PREP: Place plastic drop cloth on the ground and tape down. Then place canvas drop cloth right on top of the plastic one and tape that down as well.

STEP 2

PRIME: Once both your plastic and canvas drop cloth are taped in place, pour gesso into a tray and using a roller (or regular brush) begin to coat the canvas until it is completely covered. Then, let the canvas dry.

STEP 3

TRANSFER: Now its time to transfer the design onto the canvas. This step requires the use of a projector. You also want to do this step at night or in a dark space in order to see the design clearly when it is projected. Once your canvas is dry, tape the canvas onto a wall. If the canvas does not stay, consider using grommets (See step 5). Line of the projection onto the canvas and trace the design with a pencil!

STEP 4

PAINT: Put your canvas back onto the plastic drop cloth. Start with the color that has the most coverage and work your way to the color that has the least coverage. It will feel like you are getting things done way faster! *PRO TIP: always work from background to foreground.

STEP 5

Once the banner is dry, you can install grommets to make it easier to hang! I suggest installing 5.

PRO TIP: Use scissors to make the hole instead of using the grommet hole puncher. It is much easier and faster!



COVID-19 GUIDELINES

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS MURAL SAFELY

STAY HOME IF SICK

Please stay home if sick or exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms such as fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell, or nausea/vomiting.

WEAR A MASK

Please wear your mask properly (covering both mouth and nose) at all times in order to ensure everyone is protected. Wearing a faceshield is encouraged for extra protection. The only time a mask should be lowered is when taking a sip of water.

6 FEET APART

Try to maintain a social distance of 6 feet or more in any room. Also make sure the room or space is well-ventilated.

NO MORE THAN 5 PEOPLE AT A TIME

When working on the mural, please ensure no more than 5 people are working on it at a time. You can switch out people if need be, or create scheduled times for groups to work on the mural.

SANITIZE

Make sure to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds before and after arriving. Once you are done using a supply, please make sure to sanitize it. We encourage wearing gloves so there isn't a need to sanitize as often.

STAY HYDRATED

When wearing masks for prolonged periods of time, it is important to make sure you get plenty of fluids.
